

1. Credibility & Recognition

Increase your positive perception among consumers and business owners. Consumers believe that companies active in a local chamber of commerce use good business practices, are reputable, care about their customers, and are involved in the community. 2. Visibility & Promotion

Enhance your visibility and presence within the physical community and online. Receiving referrals or endorsements from the Chamber or other members businesses can lead to a steady stream of loyal customers and growth for your business. In this digital age, online connections are critical and you certainly don't want to be the business that is not being promoted among your competitors.

- ★ Members are listed on the Chamber's website, where they may be searched alphabetically or based on the category of services provided. Contact info can also be linked to a business website or social media profiles.
- ★ Save on advertising dollars through free member promotions in Chamber newsletters, e-blasts or social media posts. Special events, fundraisers, discounts, sales, and other activities can all be highlighted to a large audience.
- ★ The Chamber displays and distributes promotional materials (business cards, pamphlets, coupons, stickers, magnets, samples, etc.), where only items from Chamber members are included in the Welcome Bags given out to new residents or organizations.

3. Networking & Resources

When you are a new business or a small startup entering the market, having a support system is crucial. Chamber membership provides access to people that are familiar with your local economy and demographics, and who have a wealth of knowledge and expertise, to help you to make informed decisions and navigate the challenges of running a successful business.

- ★ Various opportunities to meet potential partners and customers are provided through Chamber sponsored events such as meet-and-greet coffees, ribbon cuttings, business roundtables or expos, community events, annual awards, and more.
- ★ The Chamber also offers one-on-one business consulting or access to resource partners for topics such as marketing, financing, social media, business planning, grant applications, regulatory issues, and more.
- ★ The Chamber promotes and **supports local workforce** needs. Job postings may be included on the Chamber website or newsletters.
